- You may enter more than one Scarecrow
- Any safe, non-flammable materials may be used to make your scarecrow
- Scarecrows can be dropped off at Church Knowle ahead of the event as we'd love to display them around site. Scarecrows are welcomed from Monday 10th September, please call ahead on 01929 480474 or email teamgreen@mgar.org.uk to let us know you are coming
- Scarecrows must be available to be displayed on site by 12:00 on Sunday 23rd September 2018
- Entry is open to all ages, to groups, clubs, school classes and individuals
- Please complete a Scarecrow entry form, and return to Church Knowle Rehoming and Visitor Centre ahead of the event, if you enter on the day, please hand the completed entry form to a member of MGAR staff
- If your Scarecrow has a name please clearly display that on your entry
- Judging will take place throughout the Country Fayre on 23rd September at Margaret Green Animal Rescue, Rehoming and Visitor Centre, Church Knowle, Wareham BH20 5NQ by way of event visitors donating money to the Scarecrow(s) they like best
- The winner will be announced at around 16:00 at the end of the Country Fayre on 23rd September and if not on site will be notified on 24th September
- Entrants will be able to collect their Scarecrow and prize (if won) when the event closes at 16:00, although we'd love to display them on site so we'd be happy if you to left them with us!
- All entrants will receive a certificate
- MGAR cannot be held responsible for any breakages or loss of your Scarecrow
- The Judges' decision is final
- The winner will receive a behind the scenes tour of Church Knowle Rehoming and Visitor Centre on a date and time to be organised. No alternative cash or prize available
